National Backpack Awareness Day

Today is National School Backpack Awareness Day.

Improper use can lead to back pain or injury, which can impact learning. So take a few moments today to check your backpack!

1. *Use both straps* - Slinging your backpack on one shoulder can lead to bad posture, and injury or pain.
2. *Adjust the height* - Backpacks should be worn high on your back; they should sit an inch or two above your hips.
3. *Use the waist and chest strap* - The horizontal straps help distribute the weight and keep your load stable as you move.

HSPT (High School Placement Test)

All 8th Grade students who wish to apply to a Catholic High School in the Archdiocese of Baltimore will take the HSPT on Wednesday, December 2nd during the school day. Testing will occur in the morning and all students taking the test, including our Remote Learners, will need to come to the school to test in safe, socially distanced spaces. Those students not taking the HSPT test will be given assignments to complete remotely.

Registration started yesterday and is \$40 per student. 8th Grade families should check their email for more information on the HSPT details.
